Schoolwork consists of both homework assignments and in-class assignments. The expectations are the same for both homework and in-class assignments.

It also helps foster responsibility, which is an important life skill. Students at Edison Middle School are expected to complete assigned homework and have assignments prepared for class.

Consequences for Missed and Late Assignments

In a grading period, students who **miss 4 or more assignments in a class** will receive after school detention. Each assignment missed after the initial detention will result in additional detentions.

Also, in a grading period, students who have **4 or more late assignments in a single class or 6 or more late assignments across all of their classes** will be excluded from Opportunity Day at the end of the grading period.
