Consequences for Missed and Late Assignments

In a grading period, students who **have 4 or more missing and/or late assignments in a class** will receive after school detention. Each missing and/or late assignment after the initial detention will result in additional detentions.

Also, in a grading period, students will be excluded from Opportunity Day for any of the following:

- **any missing assignments**
- **4 or more late assignments in a single class**
- **6 or more late assignments across all of their classes**
