Lohr's School Wide Discipline Plan

- You child's class will have a "Wheel" divided into sections with the following colors:
Great! green
Oops! green
Warning 1 yellow
Warning 2 yellow
Severe blue
Principal red
- Each student will have a clothespin with his name on it. Every student's clothespin will be clipped on the *Great!* section of the wheel to start each day.
- If a student fails to follow a rule or warning, he will be asked to move his clip to the next section on the wheel. Students that keep their clothespin in the green zone will bring a green card home indicating they had a great day at school. The teacher or student will write on a color-coded card why the student moved his clip and place this card in a special pocket glued into your child's Home Folder or School Planner. If a student moves out of the green zone, they will bring a yellow, blue, or red card home.
- Students will move their clips in order (without skipping sections) on the wheel. Exception: A teacher may have a student move his clip directly to the *Severe* or *Principal* section, if necessary.
- The teacher or principal will determine appropriate consequences. Every situation deserves individual attention.
- Look in your child's Home Folder nightly to see what color of card your child earned for that day. Please sign and return all *Warning*, *Severe*, and *Principal's* cards. *Great/Opps* cards do not need signed.
- Students will set behavior goals and earn classroom and school wide incentives for accumulating green cards. The classroom teachers will develop these incentives with their students.

Please spend some quality time with your child nightly to review the Home Folder, praise good choices, set expectations for improvement, and encourage success. If you should have any questions, please feel free to give me a call at 330-484-3924.
