Planting Tips:

AGERATUM – Full sun to partial shade; average, well drained soil, dead head for continued bloom; can be used as a border.

ALYSSUM – Full sun to light shade; well drained, moist soil, prune after first wave of flower to prolong bloom.

BEGONIA – Full sun to light shade; moist soil in rich humus.

LOBELIA – Full sun to partial shade to prolong bloom; cut back lightly in mid-summer.

IMPATIENS – Filtered sun to partial shade; fertile, well drained soil with ample moisture.

MARIGOLDS – Full sun, average soil; deadhead to prolong bloom.

PANSY – Full sun to partial shade; moist, well drained soil rich in humus, deadhead to prolong flowering; pinch plant back to compact.

PETUNIAS – Full sun; well drained soil, deadhead to prolong bloom.

DWARF SNAPDRAGONS – Full sun to partial shade; average moisture, well drained
