## **PARENTS: DROP OFF AND PICK UP TIMES**

- **Drop off student at Pfeiffer no later than 8:45 AM on Wednesday morning. (Students can't ride buses with camping gear).**
- **Have all camping gear secure with name on the outside**
- **Bedding in large trash bags to keep dry and clean....name on outside**
- **Check in with teacher immediately inside the main door**
- **If applicable, have medications in proper containers and camp money (There's a store on site for souvenirs etc. which is optional. Money will be held by chaperones and any money not used will be returned to your child on Monday, May 19<sup>th</sup>).**
- **Pick up your child at 1:30 pm on Friday at Pfeiffer. (Students can't ride buses with camping gear).**

## Nature's Classroom Camp Store Information

Each student who wished to buy camp store materials must turn his/her money to their teacher at school prior to going to Nature's Classroom. The teacher keeps a list of who turned in money and how much they turned in. This total sum of collected money along with the list will be turned in to the Nature's Classroom director upon arrival to camp. *Students are not to have any money with them while they are at Nature's Classroom.*

During their free time they will have the opportunity to go to the camp store and purchase materials. A running tab will be kept for each individual on how much they spent and how much "remains in their account".

When it is near departure time, all remaining monies and a comprehensive list of transactions (including who gets money back and how much) will be given to a school representative (classroom teacher).
