

## **PERRY HIGH SCHOOL DANCE EXPECTATIONS**

All students attending a dance at Perry High School must obey the following rules. No warning will be given if you break a rule. You will be immediately removed from the dance and will not be readmitted; you could also be subject to additional school punishments. All school rules are in effect at every school function, and alcohol and drugs are not permitted before, during, or after the dance. Offenders will be punished in accordance with school policy. Students must also follow the listed dress code guidelines given as well as the rules for appropriate dancing.

### **Dress Code**

Men:

- All men must wear 1) shirt, 2) tie, 3) coat (when applicable), 4) dress pants, 5) dress shoes—no tennis or athletic shoes.
- No one will be permitted to wear costumes of any sort.

Women:

- All women must wear 1) appropriate dresses—dresses and slits must be at or below the wearer's mid-thigh—strapless dresses are permitted, 2) undergarments, 3) dress shoes (must be worn to and from the dance).
- No one will be permitted to wear any dress with excessive cleavage, backs that go below the waist, sheer/see-through dresses that have a bare midriff. Specifically, two piece dresses that show the midriff are prohibited.

### **Dancing**

- No sexually-suggestive dancing
  - No front to back touching/grinding
  - No straddling legs
  - No bending over in a sexually suggestive manner
