Students taking CCP classes at PHS: All completed paperwork/forms are due to the Counseling Office no later than March 9, 2018

Students wishing to attend a college campus to complete CCP courses MUST MEET WITH THEIR HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR WITH A PARENT, NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, MARCH 24

ACT: Go to www.actstudent.org to create an account and to sign up for a test

Test Dates: Oct. 28, Dec.9, Feb. 10, April 14, June 9

Scores needed for College Readiness: Reading 22, Math 22, and English 18. Check the CCP Information book for the specific course score requirements.

SAT: www.sat.org/register to create an account and to sign up for a test.

Test Dates: Nov. 4, Dec. 2, Mar. 10, May 5, June 2

Scores needed for College Readiness: Math 530, Evidence based Reading and Writing -480

ACCUPLACER: STUDENTS MUST HAVE A STARK STATE ID or Social Security number (last 4 digits) TO REGISTER FOR THE ACCUPLACER TEST AT PHS.

Scores needed for College Readiness: Writeplacer 5, Reading 80, Elementary Algebra 108

Students must register for the Accuplacer on the PHS Counseling website by the registration deadline.

High School Student test dates: Students MUST bring their laptop on test day to take the test.

Students WILL use THEIR laptop to take the test

All tests will be taken in the PHS school cafeteria

Test Dates: November 8-9 (registration Oct. 10-Nov.2)
December 13-14 (registration Nov. 6- Dec. 8)
January 23, 25 (registration De. 11-Jan. 17)
February 21-22 (registration Jan. 22-Feb. 12)

Edison student test dates: test will take place in the Edison Library immediately after school

February 6-7 (registration Jan. 3-Jan. 26) - **seats are limited**
