Changes to Ohio Revised Code have schools monitoring student attendance more closely than ever. We are now required to begin sending letters to all families at specific increments whether absences are excused (via a medical excuse) or unexcused. (Your allotted vacation days do NOT count.) Please be aware you may receive a letter regarding attendance. Should your child reach a point of concern (Habitual Truancy) you will receive an additional letter and a personal phone call from Mrs. Daugherty.

### General Housekeeping...

- Students who do NOT come to school with a coat/jacket will NOT be permitted to go to outside recess when the temperature (chill factor) is 40 degrees or below.
- Please MARK your child's belongings (coats, lunch boxes, etc.) with their name or initials. Our Lost-n-Found box is already full of these items!
- If you are joining your student for lunch and purchasing a lunch from the cafeteria, please send a note or call first thing (by 9:30 A.M.) in the morning so we are sure enough food is prepared!
