

Whipple Heights Elementary School Parent-Teacher Organization Scholarship

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this program is to provide financial assistance to a former Whipple Heights Elementary School student who is a graduating senior of Perry High School planning to attend an accredited post-high school education program.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior of Perry High School and have completed at least four years of grade school at Whipple Heights Elementary School. (Exception: In the case where a student was forced to change elementary schools because of district policy to redistrict elementary schools.)
2. Applicant must not apply to another Perry elementary school for a scholarship.
3. Award shall be granted without regard to sex, race, creed, or color.
4. Must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5.

PROCEDURE:

1. Two \$750.00 scholarships will be awarded and presented at the Award Ceremony.
2. Student must **return application by March 31, 2014 to the Perry High School Guidance Office.**
3. DO NOT forward applications to Whipple School.
4. NO late applications will be accepted.
