Jamie Dulcie- \$16,404.91 was raised and that is about \$4500.00 less than last year. We may need to extend the turn around to two weeks as suggested by the group. Prizes have been ordered and are in for a total \$884.00. We have 120 limo rides and will drop from 3 runs to 2 runs at a cost \$1566.00. We are still expected to come out ahead. Prizes and shirts will go home at the same time. Limo ride will be November 2nd, permission slips and requests for volunteers will be going home soon. Some parents inquired as to why the t-shirts only offered to \$75 donations. It was explained that the prize levels were broken down by the cost of the prize and how many people we have reach that level. Additional costs include \$76.44 in supplies, \$303.75 for the staff shirts, \$685.44 for CiCi's as projected numbers. We budgeted \$4000.00 for the event and \$600.00 for staff shirts. Jamie came in under budget so we look to clear \$16, 839.00. Thanks for everyone's help!!
