If you plan to participate in a sport next year, we encourage you to take advantage of this offer! Aultman will provide physicians, residents, and nurses who will come to Perry High School on Friday, May 31<sup>st</sup>, starting at 1:45 PM.

The **\$10.00 fee is not due until Physical Day.**

To take advantage of this offer:

- Complete the 2019-2020 information on Final Forms at <https://perrymassillon-oh.finalforms.com>
- Print out the OHSAA PPE Physical (for Physicians) and make sure parent/guardian and athlete sign where indicated before turning in this paperwork to the Perry Athletic Office by **May 24<sup>th</sup>**.

\*Students entering Grades K-6 will need to contact the Athletic Office to obtain a manual form as the above form is only applicable for Grades 7-12.\*

On May 31<sup>st</sup>, the athlete will check-in to receive paperwork for the physical and pay their \$10.00 cash or **check made payable to: PERRY LOCAL SCHOOLS**. Athletes will not be permitted to receive a physical if they do not have the completed and signed OHSAA form listed above.

Also, please plan to attend a **meeting for parents of student athletes entering Grades 7-12 on May 28<sup>th</sup> @ 6:00 PM inside Perry's Mattachione Theatre** to provide important updates regarding OHSAA Regulations & By-Laws, Booster Clubs, Contest Travel Release forms, school day cancellation procedures, spectator/athlete expectations, and to explain general operations of the Athletic Department. Immediately following, there will be an informative **Free College Academic & Athletic Scholarship Education Seminar open to anyone in our district** designed to educate high school student-athletes and their parents, coaches, and administrators on the athletic scholarship and college selection process. This seminar will review NCAA rules, what college coaches and professors are looking for, teach how to be proactive and market oneself to colleges, and share recruiting insights from 17-year college coach, Mike Florak.
